

PACKAGINGS : CONTACT OF FOODSTUFFS & ENVIRONMENT

According to the information communicated by our suppliers of packagings, all the products of Brewline brand are in compliance with the contact of foodstuffs, and which do not arise from the nanotechnology.

These conditionings are compliant with: the following regulations and his amendments:

Contact of foodstuffs

- Regulation (EC) n°1935/2004 and French decree n°2007-766 of May 10th, 2007 concerning the capacity to be in contact with food and its good manufacturing practices defined in the Regulation (EC) n°2023/2006.
- Regulation (EC) n°10/2011 on plastic materials, like phthalates for example, that establish the specific rules that must apply to materials and plastic objects for the purposes of a safe use according to the various dates of application of this present regulation.
- French law n°2012-1442 of December 24th, 2012 to stop the manufacture, the import, the export and the launch on the market of any packaging with food contact vocation containing Bisphenol A. Our manufacturers declared not to introduce Bisphenol A into the formulations of the packagings sold to BR.

Environmental conformity

- Directive 94/62/CE modified on the requirements connected to the environment in the conception, the manufacturing of packaging and packaging waste and the French Decree n°2007-1467 concerning the book V of the statutory part of the environment code and modifying other certain measures of this code.
- Directive 2008/98/CE which establishes a legal framework for the treatment of waste within the EU and the French Decree n°2011-828 carrying diverse measures relative to the prevention and to the waste management.
